


STRATAGAME transnational meeting in Rzeszow



On 18 and 19 November 2019 the STRATAGAME * project partners met in Rzeszow, Poland, for the 3rd transnational meeting, organized by the Polish partner DANMAR. 10 people attended the meeting representing the seven partners from Romania, Italy, Spain, Poland and Turkey.

During the meeting, conducted by the representative of the Romanian leader CDA Oana Brinzan, the situation was taken into consideration, after a year of activity, compared to what was done in terms of communication and dissemination and above all with respect to the realization of the second important output of the project, the interactive game aimed at improving one's *soft skills*, which will also be submitted (as already happened for the self-diagnosis test) to an accurate preliminary test by the students and teachers of the Technical and Professional Institutes of the various countries participating in the project. The partnership has expressed considerable satisfaction with the quality and punctuality of the work carried out so far: particularly the first project result, the soft skills diagnostic skill is already finished (see <https://stratagame.erasmus.site/test-homepage/>) . The following steps were then established regarding the implementation of the *game*, especially with regard to the graphic attractiveness and effectiveness of the texts, in order to ensure the most reliable feedback possible from the "players". The first steps to be taken for the realization of the online guide for teachers, the third output of the project, were then prefigured. Finally, the organization of the important 5-day transnational work session, which is scheduled to take place in Valencia (SP) in May 2020, was discussed, where teachers and students from each of the 5 partner countries will compare their experiences and assessments with the objective of an "European" validation of the tools created within the project



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
