

MULTIPLICATION EVENT IN ROMANIA Arad Development Center Association



The CDA partner organized in Arad, on October 31, 2019, its own promotion event. There were 41 participants who were very interested: teachers and students from "Iuliu Moldovan" Technological High School Arad, "Caius Iacob" Technological and Electronics High School Arad, Technological High School "Aurel Vlaicu" Arad, Technological High School " Atanasie Marienescu "Lipova, Technological High School of Construction and Environmental Protection Arad and Technological High School" Emanuil Ungureanu "Timisoara, as well as specialized inspectors in the technological education from the County School Inspectorate Arad -, the Regional Consortium for Education from the west, the Regional Coordinator of the Center National for Occupational and Technical Education, Arad Local Partnership Development Committee, consultants in school psychology, beneficiaries of the labor market (National Council of SMEs in Romania) and Arad TV from the media.

The objective of the multiplier event was to promote the results obtained in the project till October 2019 and to give visibility to the project by showing its concrete and practical application on the ground, with the learning activity.

The event was organized in two stages: the first part was dedicated to the presentation of the project, the online test, the game and its applications, and the second part took place in the form of an Open Conference during which the participants took part in discussions regarding the technological education.

The event intended to reach the highest number of VET stakeholders at local and regional level. The expected impact on the target is the future adoption of the developed diagnostic and game within VET classrooms.

The main objectives of the project are:

- to support young people in acquiring and developing key competences for the purpose of employment,
- developing an efficient, an open and in the same time an innovative education by using ICT;
- the contribution to the professional development of VET teachers, by including common methodologies for the introduction of competencies in education programs.

In the STRATAGAME Project 7 entities belonging to 5 European countries (Romania, Poland, Spain, Turkey and Italy) are involved and has a duration of 24 months and will end on 30 September 2020.
